

Term of Reference (TOR) Consultant to review of MEL System MTG

1. Background

Moving the Goalposts (MTG) is a community-based organization committed to empowering girls and young women through football and other programs that promote gender equality, leadership, and social development. Over the years, MTG has developed a comprehensive Monitoring, Evaluation, and Learning (MEL) system to track its impact and support evidence-based decisionmaking. The MEL system plays a critical role in assessing program effectiveness, reporting to stakeholders, and refining strategies that align with MTG's mission and current Strategic Plan. However, with evolving programmatic goals, changes in the operating context, and new strategic priorities, MTG seeks to ensure that its MEL system remains relevant, effective, and aligned with its long-term objectives.

This TOR outlines the need for an external review of MTG's MEL system to assess its current effectiveness, identify areas for improvement, and provide practical recommendations. This review will support MTG's strategic vision, enhance accountability, and ensure that MTG's MEL framework aligns with best practices in the sector and continues to meet the needs of stakeholders.

- Financial proposal that specifies number of working days required and consultancy costs per objective as above
