Organizational Background

MTG is a pioneer in football for girls' empowerment in Kenya's Coast Region. Started in 2002 in Kilifi, the women-led organization works towards a fair, just and inclusive world where girls and young women's rights are acknowledged, respected and realized. It employs a rights based and sports (football) approach and focuses primarily on education, sexual and reproductive health and rights, economic empowerment and leadership development. By positively influencing and equipping communities to provide safe spaces and opportunities for girls and young women, MTG contributes to the facilitation of girls to achieve their full potential. More than nine thousand girls (aged 9 – 25 years) participate in MTG programming annually in Kilifi, Mombasa, Kwale and Tana River counties.

The consultant with the Reproductive health team will Review the developed teaching aids this will enable delivery of correct SRHR messages to our target.

This EOI is being issued to obtain proposals from highly qualified expert and experienced consultants who:

- Will deliver high quality services as outlined below with skill, integrity, accuracy and expertise.
- Are knowledgeable on use of interactive games or materials that will make the topics fun and easy to remember.
- Are subject matter experts in Sexual Reproductive Health and Rights (SRHR).
- Are experienced in coming up with teaching aids for 7 years to 13 years and on contraceptives for the peer educators.
- Offer services on a competitive fee basis.

Sexual reproductive health and rights

Contraceptives

HIV and Aids

The objectives of the Curriculum Review are:

- To simplify the technical topics and ensure that the peer educators deliver correct messages
- Come up with teaching aids that are fun and easy to use
- Ensure the materials used are user friendly according to age category.

Proposal outline

Submissions are to include the following:

- A cover letter, signed and dated, summarizing the qualifications of the consultant to engage in this project.
- References of previous similar projects undertaken
- A profile of the consultant(s) to be assigned to this assignment (key contact person for the engagement, complete CV of the individuals assigned as an appendix to the submission).
- An outline of fees which will include detailed information on all expenses required and all contractual information.
- A recent certificate of Good Conduct.
- A workplan outlining the tasks – (should be delivered within 5 working days)
- Share a sample of the work in 15 working days; the assignment should be completed in 30 days. (30th November)
